EGYPT MINING FORUM 2025

Hosted by the Ministry of Petroleum and Mineral Resources and supported by the Egyptian Mineral Resources & Mining Industries Authority, the Egypt Mining Forum 2025 continued to reinforce the momentum driving Egypt's emergence as an attractive destination for mineral exploration.

Held under the theme "Accelerating Commercial Exploration, Discovery and Extraction," the fourth edition welcomed over 5,000 participants from more than 40 countries, making it the Forum's largest and most internationally diverse gathering to date. Across two days of strategic dialogue through keynote speeches, panel discussions and presentations, ministers, senior government officials, and mining and exploration leaders outlined investment opportunities, shared best practices, and discussed pathways to unlock the full potential of Egypt's mineral wealth.

The discussions highlighted Egypt's rich geology, its strategic location within the Arabian Nubian Shield, world-class infrastructure, policy reforms, and a modernised mining code, along with efforts to maximise local value addition through the development of a competitive refining and downstream mineral sector.

Particular attention was given to the recently introduced Model Mining Exploitation Agreement, which aims to create a transparent, investor-friendly framework aligned with international best practices, providing stability and more balanced fiscal terms for investors.

Alongside the Strategic and Technical Conferences, the exhibition floor brought this momentum to life. With more than 100 global exhibitors showcasing advanced exploration technologies, mining equipment, and early-stage projects.

OPENING CEREMONY

His Excellency Karim Badawi, Minister of Petroleum and Mineral Resources, opened the Egypt Mining Forum 2025 with a keynote address highlighting why now is the moment to invest in Egypt. He spoke about the momentum created by the country's recent reforms, including the introduction of the new Mineral Exploitation Agreement Model and the transformation of the mineral authority into an economic entity.

The opening ceremony also served as a platform for Egypt to showcase its commitment to attracting international investment. Following the Minister's remarks, MoUs were signed with leading international gold mining companies, including Barrick Mining Corporation and Centamin PLC, along with Central Mining, a subsidiary of AngloGold Ashanti.

Gillian Doran, Chief Financial Officer and Executive Director of AngloGold Ashanti, then delivered a keynote reaffirming the company's plans to support the growth of Egypt's mining sector. She paid tribute to the country's rich legacy of gold mining and world-class geology, while commending government efforts to create an investor-friendly environment.

The opening ceremony concluded with a high-level ministerial panel centered on how governments can advance exploration, with particular emphasis on creating conditions that enable junior mining companies to commit capital and take on the early-stage risks of developing commercially viable mineral resources.

STRATEGIC CONFERENCE

The Strategic Conference provided a high-level platform for ministers, senior government officials, investors, and industry leaders to explore the opportunities and challenges of positioning Egypt on the global map for mineral exploration.

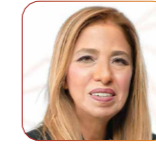

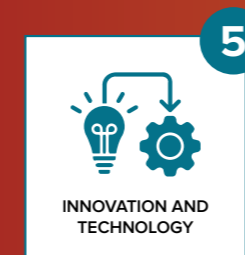

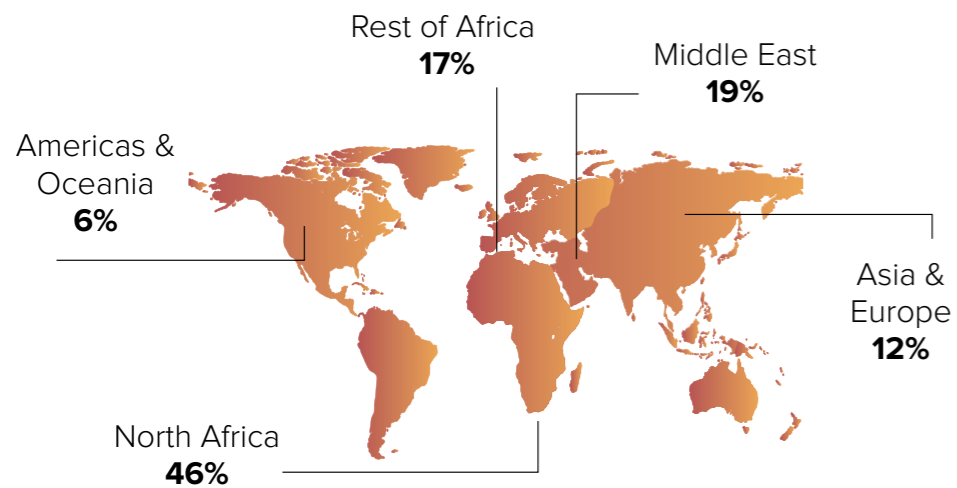


VISITOR OVERVIEW

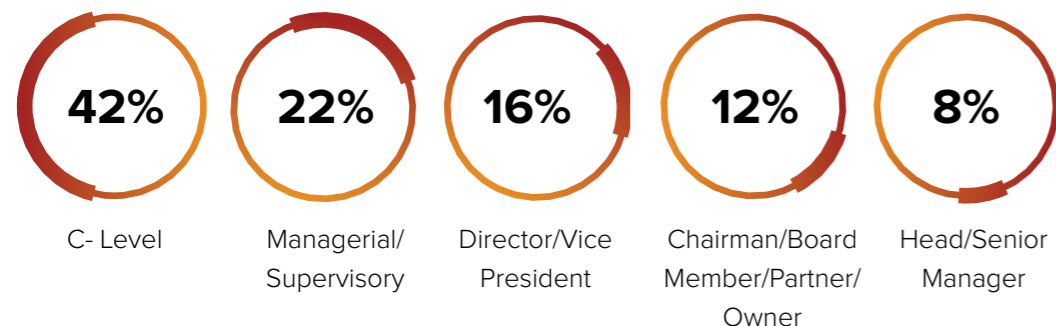

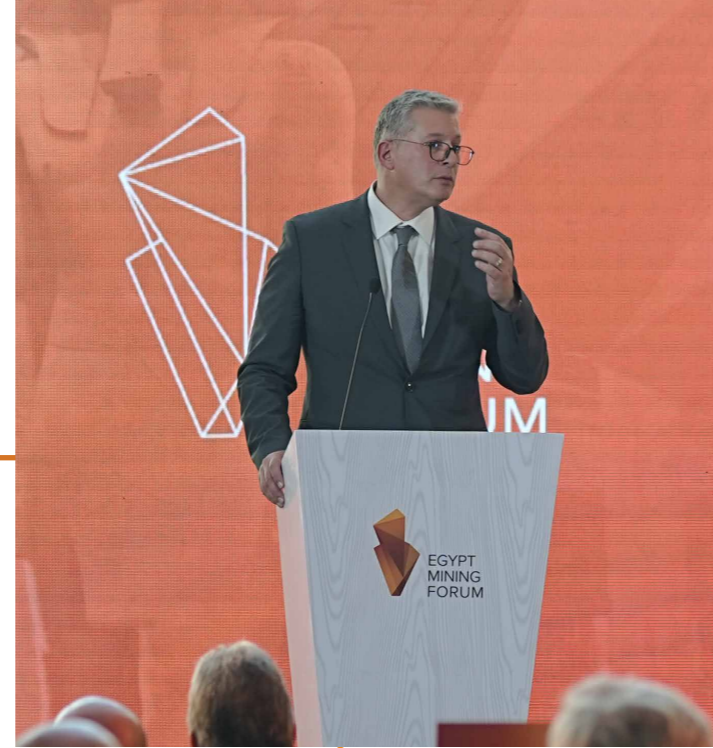
