

Hosted by the Ministry of Petroleum and Mineral Resources and supported by the Egyptian Mineral Resources Authority (EMRA), the Egypt Mining Forum 2024 brought together senior government officials, policymakers, mining and exploration thought leaders, as well as financial institutions and investors.

Under the theme "Exploring Untapped Mining Opportunities and New Commercial Discoveries," the two-day event welcomed 4,355 attendees, providing insights into the key steps Egypt is taking to become the next major exploration hub. Through a series of keynote speeches, fireside chats and panel discussions, the Forum delved into strategies, regulatory frameworks and investments

needed to make Egypt an attractive destination for global mining investors. The Forum also highlighted Egypt's competitive advantages, including its strategic location, rich geological potential, infrastructure, and a skilled workforce with competitive wages, all pointing to the country's promising mining opportunities.

Additionally, the exhibition featured over 89 international exhibitors showcasing a wide range of mining technologies, tools, equipment, and solutions aimed at driving operational excellence. Attendees were given the opportunity to discover the latest developments, innovations and practices shaping the future of the industry.



The third edition of the Egypt Mining Forum kicked off with an opening speech by His Excellency Karim Badawi, as part of his first public engagement since becoming the Minister of Petroleum and Mineral Resources for Egypt.

In his address, HE Karim Badawi emphasised the significant potential of Egypt's mining sector, boosted by the ongoing economic reform programme. He spoke in great length on how the new government is working closely with other ministries and agencies to create a regulatory framework that not only makes the sector more attractive to investors but also accelerates the decision-making and investment processes.

One of the most anticipated announcements from HE Badawi was the introduction of the Egypt Mining Portal, a digital investment platform that would begin trial operations before launching fully by the end of the year. The development of the portal will improve transparency and streamline access to key data for investors. This initiative aims to enhance opportunities and facilitate investment processes, while also provide vital information about Egypt's mineral reserves, exploration projects and market trends.

The Minister highlighted the Forum's important role in supporting the mining sector's ambitions, as well as its value in delivering critical resources for growth, energy transformation, and creating a better future. He reaffirmed the government's determination, led by Prime Minister HE Dr. Mostafa Madbouly, to increase the mining sector's contributions and economic returns to the country's GDP by overcoming investment obstacles. He stated, "We are working to uncover the full potential of Egypt's mining sector, address challenges, and build on success stories through transparent and honest dialogue. This inclusive approach supports continuous progress, a sustainable future, and the common interests of the state, investors, citizens, and communities while protecting the environment."

In his closing remarks, HE Badawi expressed confidence in the future of Egypt's mining sector, stating that with continued support from the government, private sector, and international partners, Egypt is well-positioned to become a regional hub for mining investments.






VISITORS BY REGION




